# Spring Tree Care Checklist for Reno, NV Homeowners

## **Inspect for Winter Damage**

Check for cracked limbs, leaning trunks, and exposed roots. Schedule a professional inspection if needed.

## Prune for Health & Shape

Remove dead or risky branches. Promote healthy growth and improve sunlight penetration.

## **Mulch the Right Way**

Apply 2-4 inches of organic mulch around the base (donut-style). Keeps roots cool and moist.

## **Deep Water Early**

Water slowly and deeply at the drip line. Avoid shallow daily watering.

#### **Fertilize if Needed**

Only fertilize after a soil test. Over-fertilizing can harm tree health.

### Watch for Pests & Disease

Look for spotted leaves, oozing sap, or changes in foliage. Early detection is key.

### **Plant New Trees**

Spring is ideal! Choose drought-tolerant and native species for Reno's climate.
